Results of Various Population Censuses

What is a Census of Population?

Census of Population is the complete count of all residents, both Filipinos (including overseas workers) and foreigners who have stayed or are expected to stay for at least a year in the Philippines. This also includes gathering of basic information about each individual such as age, sex, marital status, education, and other demographic characteristics.

How many Censuses of Population have been undertaken so far?

Twelve censuses of population have been undertaken since the turn of the 20th Century: 1903, 1918, 1939, 1948, 1960, 1970, 1975, 1980, 1990, 1995, 2000 and 2007.

What is the legal basis for conducting the Census of Population?

Section 2 of Commonwealth Act No. 591, approved on August 19, 1940, authorized the Bureau of the Census and Statistics (now the National Statistics or NSO) to collect by enumeration, sampling or other methods, statistics and other information concerning population and to conduct, for statistical purposes, investigations and studies of social and economic conditions in the country, among others.

What agency is responsible for the conduct of the Census of Population?

The National Statistics Office is mandated by Commonwealth Act. No. 591 as the sole government agency to undertake Census of Population and all other censuses as may be designated by the National Statistical Coordination Board (NSCB).

What are the basic uses of statistics derived from a Census of Population?

In government:

- Formulation of policies, preparation of plans and programs concerning population;
- Redistricting and apportionment of congressional seats;
- Allocation of resources and revenues; and
- Creation of political and administrative units

In Business and Industry:

- Determining sites for establishing businesses;
- Determining consumer demands for various goods and services; and
- Determining supply of labor for the production of goods and services.

In Research and Academic Institutions:

- Conduct of researches on population and other disciplines;
- Study and design of small area statistics; and
- Study of population growth and distribution as basis in preparing projections

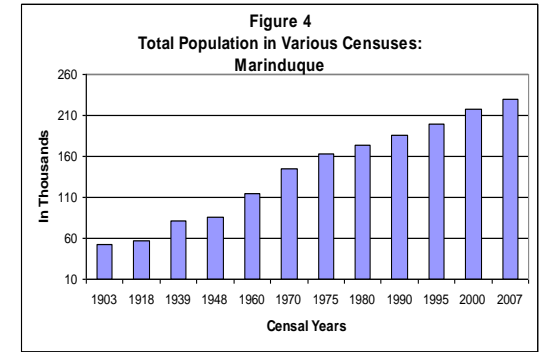

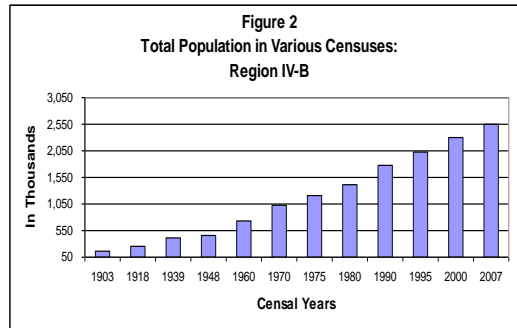

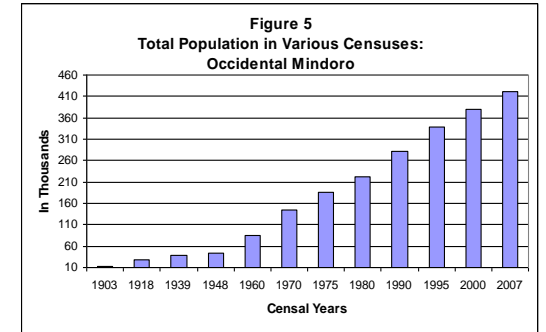
